

PROGRAM ITINERARY

Day 1 – Wednesday, January 23rd

- Arrival in Brasilia (night)
- Transfer to Brasilia Hostel (www.brasiliahostel.com.br)

Day 2 – Thursday, January 24th

- Breakfast in the hostel
- Brief lecture with the group professor in order to present the participants and give general explanations about the program, agreements and rules
- Visit to the TV Tower (panoramic view of the city)
- Lunch and visit to Plano Piloto (Part I): Presidencial Palace (Palácio do Planalto), Itamaraty (Ministry of Foreign Relations), three powers square (Praça dos três poderes), Cathedral
- Return to hostel – evening free



Day 3 – Friday, January 25th

- Breakfast in the hostel
- Visit to Plano Piloto (Part II): National Congress, JK Memorial, Alvorada Palace, National Museum, Church, Square 107, Councilor Chamber
- Transfer to the airport (late afternoon)
