We are looking for students studying, or having keen interest in biology or ecology; specifically with interest for experimental ecological research, field work, climate change, ecosystems, biodiversity and/or plant sciences. Previous experience with field work and/or outdoor work is beneficial. Must be willing and able to work irregular hours while in the field, to travel, and do outdoors field work in coastal, alpine and boreal habitats in Western Norway.

### Work Offered

The student will be assisting teams of scientists and PhD students working on various projects (LandPress, Three-D and INCLINE), that focus on climate change and effects on alpine grassland - and coastal heathland biodiversity, ecosystem processes, and conservation.

Tasks will include participation in field work in alpine and boreal regions in Western Norway: assisting in botanical surveys, vegetation sampling, and environmental monitoring, applying experimental treatments, logging climate and environmental data, etcetera. Some lab work may also be anticipated.

Note that we have irregular hours due to travel to the field, and do outdoors work in all weather. Extra costs for lodging and food "during field work days" will be covered by the employer.
