Assist and support to the professionals in the mentioned areas. The professionals (doctor, nurse, physiotherapist, dentist, etc.) work at the Home for very few hours per day, so the interns support them during those few hours and the rest of the day during work hours. Interns will also have the possibility to assist at the local hospital.

All the work will be under the direct supervision and guide of the Medical Chief of the home, Dr. Carmelo Vasquez, pediatrician.

This is a home for 115 children (also grown ups) with different types of disabilities, mostly brain paralysis, autism, and so. It is runned by the catholic church, an order of priests from Colombia, but they also have support from the state government. The administration is professional (paid by the state government).

The medical staff is also paid by the government, but they need more.
